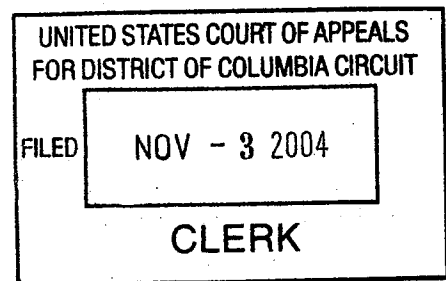

Upon consideration of the motion for a voluntary partial remand, the response thereto, and the reply, it is

ORDERED that the motion be granted to enable respondents to propose a standard covering asbestos and asbestos-like fiber emissions from taconite iron ore processing facilities. The court takes note of respondents' stated intention to "act with all due speed to propose, take comment on, and issue a final rule." Mot. at 5.
