SEP Policy & Criteria

Required Elements

- ✓ Furthers CARB's purpose
- ✓ Nexus to violation
- ✓ Does not benefit violator
- ✓ Above & beyond regs
- √ Feasible

Preferential Elements

- Direct emissions or exposure reduction
- + Benefits disadvantaged communities
- + Community benefits
- + Addresses multiple environmental problems



SEP Proposals



- Proposals accepted year-round
- Listed until fully funded
- Ineligible proposals may be revised & resubmitted




Proposal Elements

- Applicant experience
- Community partners & contractors
- Environmental issue(s) to be addressed
- Expected benefits

Quarterly Reports

- Key activities and results
- Expense reports

Final Report

- Narrative of successes, challenges, benefits
- Evaluation of project objectives and outcomes


Close-Out
